ASSISTING IN SECURING A FAMILY'S HOME



Saba Abdo Mohammed is a 39 years old married woman. Her family consists of 6 members, 3 sons and 1 daughter their ages between 2-8 years old. Saba is a poor housewife depends on tailoring to

ensure her small family basic life-requirements. Her husband moved illegally to Saudia in order to look for a work opportunity that helps in covering life his family needs.



Saba was displaced internally from Dhamar city in 2020 and seated in Marib Alwady- Gosen camp- along with her children leaving behind all their assists. She is in a very poor humanitarian status, as she lives in a hut made up of branches and roofed by blankets, which were donated by neighbors Furthermore, the hut was built in a

temporary donated piece of land. Then, Saba was supported by an emergency shelter kit, Bedding kit for 5 family members and core-NFI Kit. There were no difficulties within and during assessment and distribution of the support, as the process went very smoothly along with sincere gratitude.



"There is a huge change in climate and atmosphere of Dhamar city and Marib Alwady district." Saba mentioned. Therefore, she and her family suffered from a very hot dry weather during summer, while a very dry cold weather during winter , in addition to the sand storms.

Moreover, there are many recurrent crisis

that makes stabilization more difficult and impossible. For example, frequent changes of climate accelerates damages of huts, and rainy seasons that destroys the hut besides the financial burdens we put for rehabilitation. Consequently, a well designed shelter supported with toilets is essentially needed.



Success is reached in assisting and providing a temporary standardized shelter that is capable to stand frequent climate changes for a temporary period, also by targeting neglected beneficiaries of high priorities.

The provided support played a great role in revealing Saba's concerns and her family financial condition, as it assisted in upgrading her ability in tailoring.
